James Nisbet, Sorn Mains, Mauchline, took the supreme cattle championship for the second year in succession at the recent LiveScot event held at Lanark.

Starlight was a 704kg Limousin cross heifer, bred by James Huck, and went on to make £9800 when being knocked down to Andrew Ewing.

Reserve went to a similar type, Phoenix from Stuart and Lynsey Bett, Boquhan Home, having been bred by Balfour Baillie, this 666kg heifer now heads to the Welsh Winter Fair.

Overall steer champion was Andrew Gammie's Top Boy, from Drumforber, Laurencekirk. This Limousin cross crossed the weigh bridge at 758kg having sold for 355p per kg, resulting in £2690.90 cheque for Bowland Foods Ltd.

Another Limousin cross, Tyson, from Wilson Peters, Cuilt Farmhouse, stood reserve steer. This 788kg sold for 254p per kg, when the hammer fell to Kitson butchers.

From the unaltered classes, the champion was Andrew Purdon's 602kg heifer, off Stravenhouse, which went on to make 432p when selling to the judge, Strachan Craft Butchers, Blantyre.

Mr Strachan also selected his housewives choice as a 542kg Limousin cross bullock from Jean Mackay Parker, Auchenaimey. Christened Gold Rush and backed his decision and purchased her for 443p.

At the end of the day 35 cattle sold to average £2520.72 or 3.88p per kg, followed by 43 Lanarkshire Young Farmers' calf rally entries, which cashed in at £1925.10 or 3.22p.

Among the sheep, the champion came from John Guthrie, Cuiltburn, which later made £300 per head to local butchers, MJ Stark. This Beltex duo weighed in at 41kg.

The Halls, Inglewood Edge, Dalston, scoped the reserve title with Texels which were also later purchased by MJ Stark at £250, having weighed 39kg.

Also making £250 per head was a 47kg Beltex duo from Sean Young, Tormitchell, when selling to John Scott Meats, Paisley.

Supreme among the Blackface was a pair of 48kg from R and B Dickie, Spango, and went on to realise £220 to Russell Lawson, Midseat.

The best pen of sheep in the Cheviots section went to TN Cavers, Sorbie, with a pair of 50kg South Country Cheviots, when later made £144 when selling to James Champman butchers.

Cameron and Rachel Baillie, Carstairs Mains, produced the young breeders winner with a pair of 47kg Beltex lambs which achieved £170 when the hammer fell to East Mains Farm.

In total 234 lambs sold to average £140.95 per head.
