

### Strong future for two-day LiveScot event

There was a new buzz at LiveScot this year after two long years without a proper show and introducing the new pedigree calf and lamb shows to the Friday night it was a great success for the event.

Taking home, the all-important Supreme Beef cattle champion was the Charolais cross steer, Silver Lining from Craig and Teen Malone of Pitcairn. This yearling boy crossed the weigh bridge at 622kg having been bred by Duncan Semple, Dippen Farm, Argyll. Purchasing the champion once again was B and T Kitson butchers in North Yorkshire, for £5600.

Judge, Jimmy Wood of Popes Farm, Preston, had a tough job in the strong quality of cattle forward, however tapped out his reserve honours in Blair M Duffton's Babybell. This Limousin cross heifer is bred by Gary Bell weighing 574kg. This girl also travels to North Yorkshire with B and T Kitson for £3800.

Housewives choice this year was selected by Gary Raeburn, Huntly, which was awarded to Wilson A Peters' Limousin cross heifer, Roxy Delight. This girl was bred by exhibitor being 556kg on the day. Mr Raeburn backed his decision and took this one home for £4000.

Adding to the beef rings was the strong line up of commercial calves which was dominated by the Limousin cross, Brownie from Jennifer Hyslop, Settle. This home-bred calf crossed the scales at 278kg and was picked out by the judge, James Little.

Among the sheep lines, the spectacular continued, trade was on fire throughout, with the Hall family of Inglewood Edge, back in business doing the triple – after winning both live and dead at the Premier Meat Exhibition they went on to triumph at LiveScot and take the overall sheep championship.

Their pair of 42kg Beltex lambs went onto realise £680 to regular buyers at the event, Coq and Bull Ltd, Mathiesons Butchers, Edinburgh.

Judge, Harry Wood, Popes Farm, Preston, found his reserve honours in a Beltex duo from John Guthrie; Culitburn. This pair crossed the weigh bridge at 45kg and later made £400 when selling to Jimmy Stark, Bluebell, Milton of Campsie.

Mathiesons Butchers, Edinburgh, also forked out £400 for the champion hill breed pair, a Blackface duo weighing 41.5kg from Tommy and Craig MacPherson, Pitsundry, Bankfoot.

It was all go in the Dairy ring as well with double the entries than previous years, but managing to secure the top spot was Dalserf Demon Corneliske from Gavin Baillie, Over Dalserf, Ashgill, Lanarkshire. This four-year-old cow is sired by Wintersell Demon having last calved in April.

It was also a field day for the Laird family of Blyth Farms, Blythbridge, West Linton, when being awarded the blue and white ticket by judge, James Lawrie, Cuthill Towers. This heifer Blythbridge Alligator Alice is sired by Stantons Alligator.

Also held the same day was the Native Pony Winter Fair, which witnessed Andrew Bair's Whitefield Lady Catriona come out on top among the Highland ponies. This girl is sired by Glenmuir Buzzard and out of Whitefield Queen Xena.

Pipped at the post was Kate and John Dykes' Ptarmigan of Mendick. This foal is the result of Marksman of Mendick onto the Corriegen Breach dam.

Taking the supreme among the Shetland ponies was Birchmoor Simone from MJ Barugh, North Farm, backed by Birchmoor Viceroy Am1576 and out of Raeburn Spiggy Am.

The blue and white ticket was awarded to Hawkdale Dixie from Donna Lochtie. This mare is a daughter of Rosermus of Transy and out of Hawdale Destiny.

New to the line up this year was the introduction of pedigree livestock on the Friday night, which attracted breeders from all over and a great turnout of spectators for the first time.

Among the pedigree calf lines it was the Charolais that was crowned the inter-breed by judge, Harry Wood of Popes Farm, Preston. The January born calf, Brailes Samson from Brailes Livestock, was the first calf to ever pick up the championship here at Lanark. This boy is a son of Westcarse Houdini and out of Bassett Orange.

Taking the reserve inter-breed title was Solway View Pluto from Kevin Watret on behalf of the British Blue sections. This September 2020 born bull calf is a son of Bedgebury Kent and out of Solway View Nemo.

Heading up the MV accredited pedigree lambs was a Texel ewe lamb from Alan Campbell of Strawfrank, whilst the reserve was tapped out to a Blue Texel ewe lamb from Stephanie Dick, which was in the capable hands of judge, Jeff Aiken of Procters Farm.

Among the non-MV section, the pick for judge, Alex Brown of MacQueston, was a ewe lamb from George Whyte, Lintibert, with the blue and white sash going to a Bluefaced Leicester tup lamb from David Bryson, Mauchline.
